- PodPoster Playlist:
  - Long: a 10 minute version of the PodPoster

- Examples of Student Work Playlist:
  - **Capstone Projects:**
    - “Rhetorina Episode Two (Ethos)” & “Rhetorina Episode Three (Logos)”: These shorter podcasts are two parts of a five part podcast series on rhetoric, done by a student who is also a ballerina. She incorporates her dance experience into this clever and enlightening podcast designed for general listeners.
    - “A Progymnasmodcast”: This longer podcast is an argument for incorporating *Progymnasmata* into public school education.
    - “The arguments used in the last two stays of execution in the Troy Davis case”: This longer podcast involves two interviews and a discussion of rhetoric used in the Troy Davis case.
  - **Media Analysis Projects:**
    - “Media Analysis Same-Sex Marriage”: Judge examines the two 2008 Presidential candidate's views on same-sex marriage from a pro same-sex marriage standpoint.
    - “Media Analysis Cho Humor”: Cho argues that humor can be used effectively in rhetoric.
  - **Week In Review Podcasts:**
    - “WIR A Woodard B Jones Pirate Cast”: This podcast became famous during the semester, as there is nothing quite like rhetoric in a pirate talk. This podcast covers the week we did arrangement and style in class.
    - “WIR Akilah and Angela”: In this podcast, Akilah and Angela review the week we covered rhetoric today, academic arguments, and the rhetoric of science & technology.
    - “WIR Judge”: Ashley Judge present the week in review for Rhetoric & Gender/Feminism including the past and present.
    - “WIR I Cho B Domit”: Ian and Brian review the week we focused on pathos and proof.
    - “WIR Robert Manfredi”: Robert reviews a busy week that included copyright, media use & issues, a quick look at proposals, kairos, and old & new argument.
