The Extraordinary Contraptions

There are two sets of task for the Extraordinary Contraptions. I will select the set of task that best fits the user's answers to the survey questions 14 & 15.

If they have not heard of the Extraordinary Contraptions:

Task 1: You are unfamiliar with the Extraordinary Contraptions and are interested in their music. Using the band's site, listen to some of their music. When you have listened for a bit, stop the music and say to the researcher "done."

Task 2: After listening to their music, you would like to see the Extraordinary Contraptions live. Using the band's site, when and where is their next show? When you have completed this task, tell the researcher when and where their next show is and then say "done."

Task 3: You are curious about steampunk music and clothing. Using the band's site, look at a few pictures of the band to get an idea of their visual aesthetic. Then, still on the site, find out why they are dressing this way.

Task 4: You have a question for the band. Using the band's site, find out how you would contact them. Once you have this information, tell the research how you would contact the band and say "done."

If they have heard of the Extraordinary Contraptions:

Task 1: You would like to see the Extraordinary Contraptions live. Using the band's site, when and where is their next show? When you have completed this task, tell the researcher when and where their next show is and then say "done."

Task 2: You would like to purchase something from the band. Using the band's site, browse the merchandise until you find something you would like to purchase. Once you have found something, click on it to purchase it and follow the purchasing process until you see the order form and shopping cart.

Task 3: You cannot tell what Dimitri says in the first line of the song "Smote." Using the band's site, find the lyrics to this song and read the first line to the researcher.

Task 4: You would like to add to your Extraordinary Contraptions musical collection. Using the band's site, find if there is any new music to listen to or buy. Tell the researcher what you found and say "done" when done.
